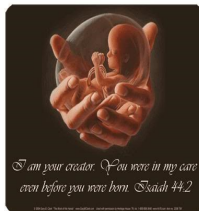
**D-of-I:**

**PARISH MISSION:**

Join us for our Parish Mission to be presented by **Fr. Jim Sichko** from Kentucky. He will be here at the weekend Masses on April 21st & 22nd, then present our mission on **April 23rd, 24th, and 25th**. It will be in Hoisington on Monday and Wednesday and in Olmitz on Tuesday, April 24th. The theme is **"60 MINUTES FOR JESUS; Praise, Laughter and Storytelling."** Fr. Jim is a full time preacher, evangelist & motivational speaker based in the Diocese of Lexington, KY. In February of 2016, Pope Francis commissioned Fr. Jim as one of his Papal Missionaries of Mercy, of which there are only 1000 in the world, 100 in the U.S. Before he became a priest, he performed as an opera singer. Since becoming a priest, he has made headlines for random acts of generosity & kindness, giving away thousands of dollars to people at the grocery store & on the street. He also has had the opportunity to meet & work with many celebrities & was honored by the U.S. Congress for his work.
